The Alexander von Humboldt Association in Germany supports foreign young talents (less than 12 years after PhD) by awarding dedicated fellowships to cover up to 2 years research in the universities and laboratories in Germany.

A special opportunity is created by the Henriette Herz Scouting Program of the Humboldt Association which avoids time-consuming review process. We aim at attracting outstanding applicants involved in the LHC experiments or collider phenomenology to conduct their projects at DESY in Hamburg.

DESY is the major national laboratory for large-scale infrastructures and has a long history in particle physics from the discovery of the gluon to the major contributions to the LHC physics. The CMS group at DESY in Hamburg offers the perfect infrastructure and unique collaborative atmosphere, participating in all aspects of the LHC physics, joint ATLAS-CMS efforts and close collaboration with world-leading theory groups.
